5. Qualifications for Program participant

- a) Participant has a clear plan or goal after he/she graduates from our school.
- b) Those who can pay the school fee, living costs, etc. while in Japan can also prove it.
- c) Those who have completed 12 years or more of school education. However, this only applies if the school education period is less than 12 years in the home country.
- d) Passed one of the following: Japanese Language Proficiency Test N5, NAT-TEST Level 5, and J-TEST E/F Level A. However, only people who, due to scheduling, were unable to take these tests will be required to have studied Japanese for 150 hours or more by time of application. We ask those who have confirmed that they will take these exams to please show the test card/vouchers.
- e) As a rule, admission to the "for further education study" course is only for those who have graduated from the last academic institution (school or university) in less than five years. There is no problem with the general course.

6. Enrollment Conditions and selection method

- a) Those who meet the above qualifications have passed our school's entrance examination and have prepared the necessary documents without delay.
- b) In the selection process, there are interviews in Japanese, written tests in Japanese, and writing in the native language. Additional tests may be conducted if necessary.

< Second-year tuition payment amount and timing>

- By the day after 6 months of your arrival in Japan, you will be required to pay 337,000 yen for the next half year's tuition and facility costs.
- · If the payment deadline date is a holiday, the deadline date will change to the day before the holiday.
- We may allow you to make installments if you cannot pay a lump sum. Don't hesitate to get in touch with us for it.

(An administration fee (2,000 yen) will be charged for each payment).

*If the consumption tax rate changes, the tuition fee may change.

<Payment of dormitory fee after coming to Japan>

• If you want to live in the dormitory for more than the contract period before you arrive in Japan, you must pay the current month's dormitory fee before the end of the previous month.

Example: The dormitory fee for August must be paid before the end of July.

• The school dormitory will be prioritized for new students, so we may not accept your request to extend your residence.

Refund: The school will send the money to your bank account. The recipient will pay the transfer fee and overseas remittance fee.

9. Part-time job

- a) Students can do part-time work while being students with the permission of the Director of the Regional Immigration Bureau work within 28 hours per week (8 hours a day during the long vacation period based on our school rules).
- b) In case of overwork, your visa renewal application is not allowed.
- c) The permission of the Director of the Regional Immigration Bureau can be obtained by submitting the required documents at the airport.
- d) The school supports students looking for part-time jobs but has yet to promise when and what kind of work they can get or how much income they will earn. It depends on the student himself/herself.

10. General living expenses while attending school

- a) The average monthly income of a part-time job is about 70,000 to 100,000 yen (950 yen to 1,000 yen per hour). It may be less depending on the content of the work and the working hours.
- b) Expenses other than tuition fees are rent at 20,000 yen (when living with friends), utility costs at 10,000 yen, food expenses at 20,000 yen, Sim card expenses at 10,000 yen, and miscellaneous expenses at 10,000-20,000 yen, totaling around 70,000-80,000 yen.

11. Notes on sending the documents

- a) For the documents required at the time of application, please see the "Required Document List."
- b) Please issue the necessary documents within 3 months from the time of application.
- c) Please attach the Japanese translation for all documents created in a foreign language. Please enter the name and address of the translator in the translation.
- d) Suppose the submitted documents are not true or suspected to be fake. In that case, even if he/she has passed the entrance examination, based on our judgment your application to the Immigration Bureau may be withdrawn. Also, please be aware that if any fake data is discovered after the admission procedure, we may cancel your admission after reporting it to the Immigration Bureau.

12. Obligations and responsibilities of financial guarantor

The sponsor has the following responsibilities:

- a) Pay the tuition fee and living cost of the student.
- b) Not only be responsible for financial problems but also take responsibility for all the student activities in Japan.
- c) If the above obligations and responsibilities cannot be fulfilled, the student may be ordered to return to his/her country.
